HIT THE BEACHES

STROLL THROUGH ORANJESTAD

You must immerse yourself in the island's art scene, by taking a self-guided **art walk through Oranjestad**. Pick up a map from the Aruba Tourism Authority or the Visitor Information Center.

Don't forget to visit the Archaeological Museum of Aruba, it showcases the island's indigenous history.



HEAD TO THE FREE CASINO

Visit Wind Creek Seaport Casino, the only waterfront casino on the island. Apart from the great views, this casino offers slot machines, traditional table games and Race & Sports books with screens.

The Wind Creek Seaport Casino is open every day from 10:00 AM until 4:00 AM.



NEVERENDING NATURE WONDERS

Visit the *Ayo Rock Formations*, located in the *Ayo Village area*, approximately 20 minutes away from the capital city.

It is a cluster of large boulders and rock formations that have been shaped by natural forces over thousands of years. These rock formations hold cultural and historical significance.



NEVERENDING DISCOVERIES

Founded in 1890, the *few Aruba Aloe Factory* is one of the few companies in the world that grows its own Aloe on site. Visit the Museum, Factory, and Store in Hato for your own free tour.

You'll learn about its history and the entire manufacturing process, from the hand cutting of the aloe leaves to the packaging of the final products.
